Bill Bolling

1991 Bill Bolling sought his first elected political office and was elected to the Hanover County Board of Supervisors and served as a member and Chairman of the Board until 1995. 1995 he was elected to the Senate of Virginia defeating a twenty year Democrat incumbent and helped the Republican Party obtain parity in the Senate for the first time.

While serving in the Senate, Bill Bolling worked to keep taxes low and create a pro-business environment in Virginia. He sponsored legislation to create a children's health insurance program, and led the fight to reduce the amount of garbage being imported to Virginia from other states. As a member of the General Assembly, he served as Chairman of the Joint Republican Caucus and the Virginia Republican Senatorial Committee. He chaired the Senate's sub-committee on Health Care, the Joint Commission on Health Care, the Commission on the Future of Virginia's Environment and the Chesapeake Bay Commission. 2005 he was elected to serve as the 40th Lieutenant Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia. As Lieutenant Governor, he has promoted a conservative legislative agenda that focuses on the things he believes in - keeping government small and focused on its core responsibilities, keeping taxes
